concert information for Nourish

Thank you for your interest in the concerts at Nourish, the festival in Bovey Tracey organised by the Contemporary Craft Festival, The Cheese Shed and Devon Guild of Craftsmen.

parking

As in many country towns, parking can be difficult in Bovey Tracey. Neither venue has parking of its own (though the Parish Church can offer a few spaces to disabled people), so your first choice will be the car parks on Mary Street, Le Molay Littry Way and Station Road. In addition, on Sat 1st, extra parking should be available for Nourish in Mill Marsh Park. Whilst there is some on-street parking this will be limited. All in all, make sure you arrive in good time to find a parking place before making your way to the venue.

at the venues

Seating is unreserved and is on a first come, first served basis.

At the Parish Church, pillars mean that there is a restricted view from some seats. You will need to arrive in good time to secure one of the best seats. Seating is in pews, so for your comfort we strongly recommend you bring a cushion.

At the Baptist Church, sightlines and seats are good.

disabled access

The **Parish Church** has level wheelchair access through the Tower door (ask a steward, and the door will be opened). There are also a few spaces for disabled people's cars to be parked in the Church car park or by the Tower, but these are <u>extremely</u> limited in number.

The **Baptist Church** has level wheelchair access around the side of the Church. Ask a steward to show you around.

running times

Evening concerts: 7.30pm to about 9.30pm (with an interval)

Saturday lunchtime concert: 1pm to about 1.45pm.

venue opening times

For evening concerts starting at 7.30pm, doors will open at 6.45.

For the Saturday concert starting at 1pm, doors will open at 12.30.

eating before the concert

If you would like to eat in Bovey Tracey before an evening concert (we suggest between 5 and 6pm), try one of the following. It is advisable to book as the town will be very busy – and please do call them first to check that they'll be open at the right time.
